To meet health guidance, livestock will not be housed at the fairgrounds during the fair with the exception being – livestock of families that show multiple species and swine. All livestock shows will be held as “Show and Go”. Youth will bring and take home their livestock the day of the show. The public is welcome to attend any of the youth events but are asked to follow the current health guidelines established by the North Central Health Department.
